

PAGUERA - ES CAPDELLÀ

Start: Peguera, Calle de Capdellà

Finish: Es Capdellà, Calle de las Playas

Distance: 11.76 km

Estimated time required: 3 h

Difficulty: Easy

Description: A very pleasant, even route which runs along the main road linking Peguera with the town of Es Capdellà. On this route we can enjoy a great variety of landscapes, including pine forests, crop fields and the Des Gorg torrent. The country estate of Son Vic Vell is particularly noteworthy in historical terms, with a defence tower dating from 1547, a granary linked to the tithes and storage of grain in Medieval times and the Torre de'n Boira, a former tower residence first built in the 14th century to defend the population from the threat of pirate attacks. The route ends in the town of Es Capdellà, whose origins lie in the houses of the jornaleros, agricultural day labourers who worked on the neighbouring country estates of Galatzó, Son Hortolà and Son Vic Vell.
