

## CALVIÀ VILA - ES CAPDELLÀ

Start: junction between “Avenida de Palma” & “Avenida de es Capdellà”, theatre “sa Societat,” Calvià

Finish: Calle Mayor, Delegation of Calvià Town Hall, c/. Mayor, es Capdellà

Distance: 7.420 m there & back

Altitude: 92 / 126 m

Estimated time required: 2 h

Difficulty: Easy

Description: This pedestrian route connects the two historic towns of the area, Calvià and Es Capdellà. The roads on this route are in good condition, making it ideal for both walkers and cyclists. The route begins on Avenida de Calvià, with beautiful views over fields of carob and almond trees, the mountains of Puig de Galatzó and La Mola de S'Esclop, the Galatzó torrent and the country estates of Mofarés and Son Alfonso. The first of these estates dates from the 14th century while the second was separated from the Galatzó estate in the 16th century. There are also some noteworthy examples of civic and religious architecture such as the Casa des Pontet in Calle Pontet and the Church of San Joan Baptista in Calvià.
